



Protocol for printing Sales Presentation

The Sales Presentation document originates in Microsoft PowerPoint. If you happen to use Google Slides or Apple's Keynote, I have included instructions for each.

Before you begin, be sure you have the proper paper on hand. This should be printed on 24# paper or higher with Brightness of 100 or higher.

Google Slides

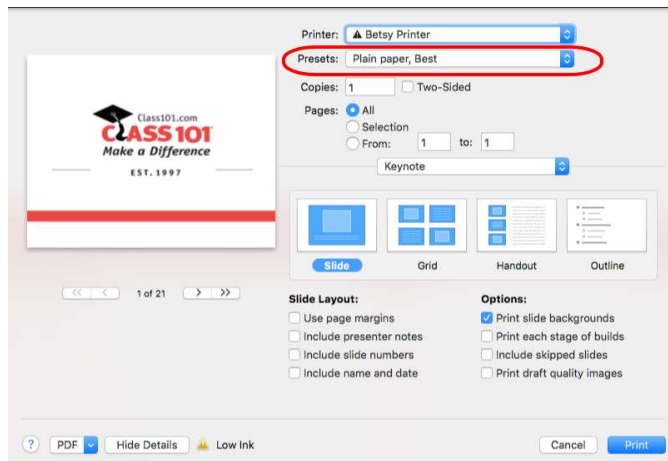
1. Just open the document in Slides, select Print Icon or File>>Print.
2. Once the Print interface opens, Expand the More settings selection, find the 'Scale' area and mark the 'Fit to page' checkbox. Select Quality – 1200 dpi – for the best quality printing.



3. Select Print

Apple Keynote

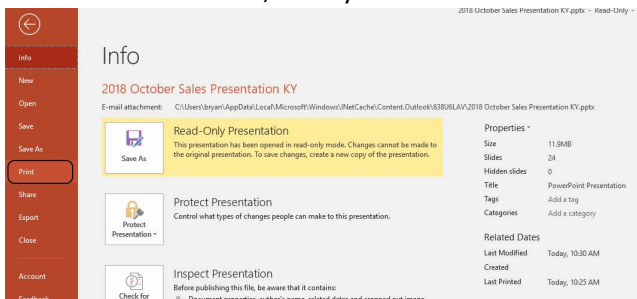
1. Open the document and select Print. On the print screen, under Presets, select Plain paper, Best. Then choose Print



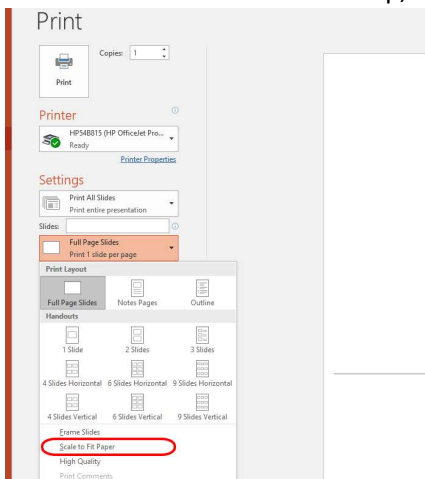


Microsoft PowerPoint

1. In the PowerPoint file, once you have filled out all of the relevant information, select File>>Print:



2. In the Print screen that comes up, select 'Scale to Fit Paper'



3. While still on this screen, select 'Printer Properties' and under 'Print quality' choose Best. Select OK to Print:
